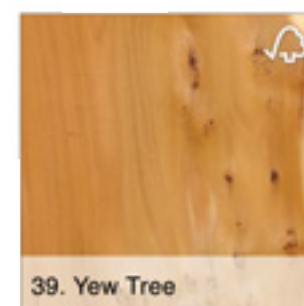
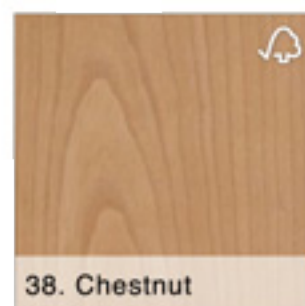
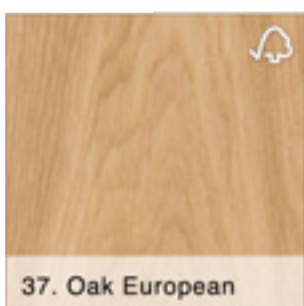
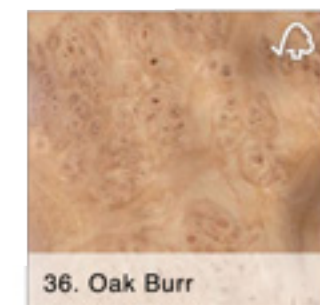
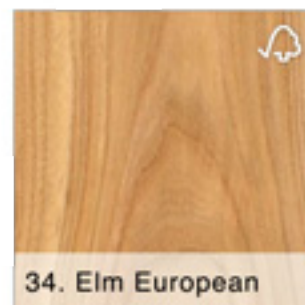
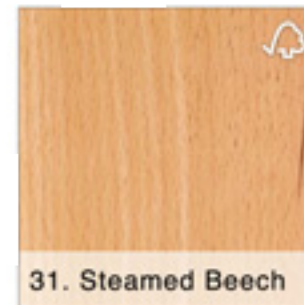
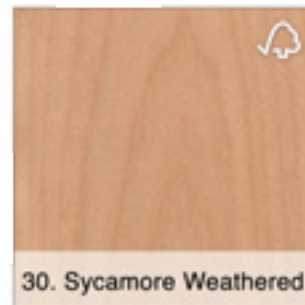
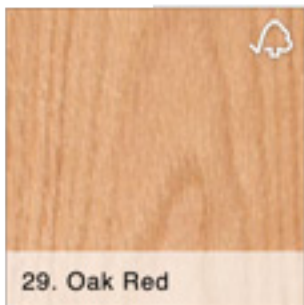
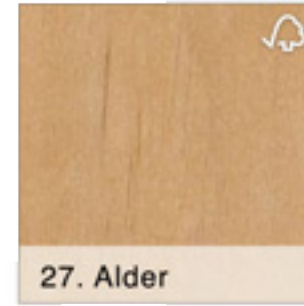
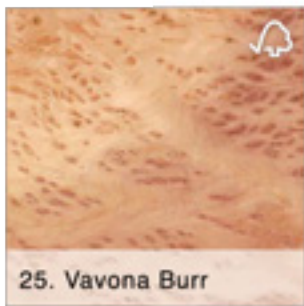
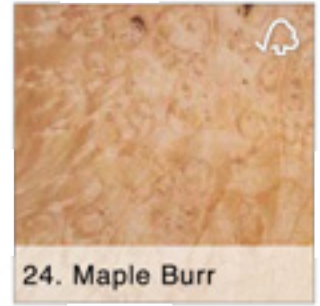
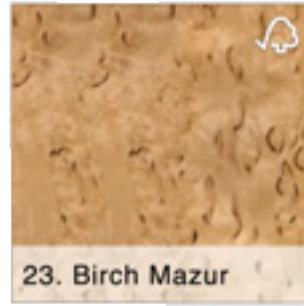
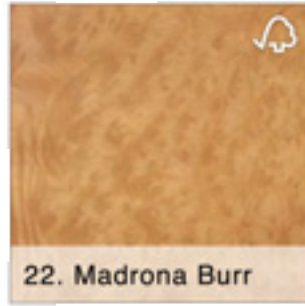
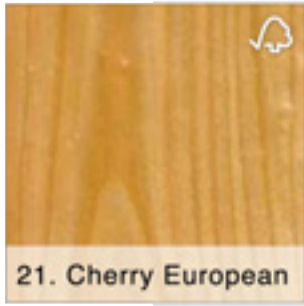
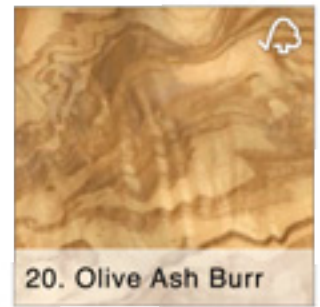
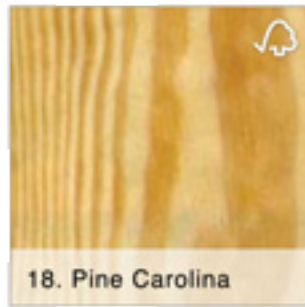
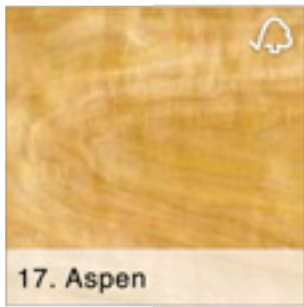
WOOD VENEERS

You can even select a different veneer for each side of the door, to suit different room styles.







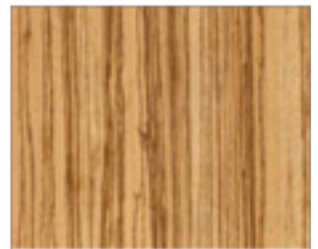

DECORATIVE FACINGS

In addition to wood veneers, we offer a full range of decorative facing options for our doors. These include:

LAMINATE

A high pressure laminate is manufactured through fusing multiple layers of impregnated paper under high pressure and temperature to create a hard wearing, durable and hygienic surfacing material. The laminates are then bonded to the core of the door. Laminates are used due to their ease of maintenance and wide range of colours and finishes.



READY PRIMED ECO-VENEER

The specially formulated eco-friendly paper veneer is applied to door blanks in the same way as a veneered layon. The pre-primed paper has been designed as a time saving initiative for paint grade doors and is ideal for under-skinning and concealing any lipping ensuring a smoother finish.



METAL FACING

Sheet metal is bonded to the door coor during the manufacturing process. The facing options include mild, patterned and brushed stainless, or galvanised steel.

Patterned steel facings can also be applied in the form of trays to fully encapsulate the door. Steel facings can be left clean, primed, powder coated or stove enamelled, with the exception of patterned stainless steel which is self-finished. Steel frames can be supplied finished to complement door facings.



FINISHES

Ahmarra's products are available in a range of factory finishes.

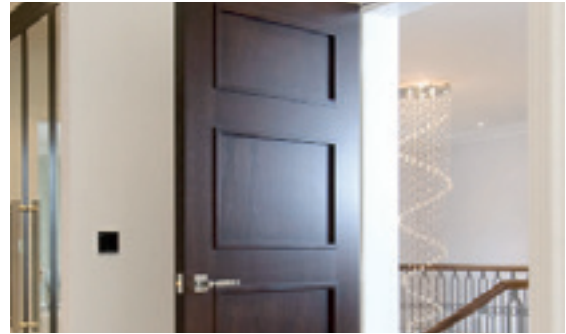
CLEAR LACQUER

A hard clear, protective coating is available in a range of finishes from matt through to high gloss.



TINTED LACQUER

A pigment is added to clear lacquer to provide a subtle, tinted effect.



STAINING

Stains are applied prior to applying the final finish to highlight the grain characteristics of the veneer and where appropriate match or compliment furniture and flooring. Our image shows the veneer before and after staining.



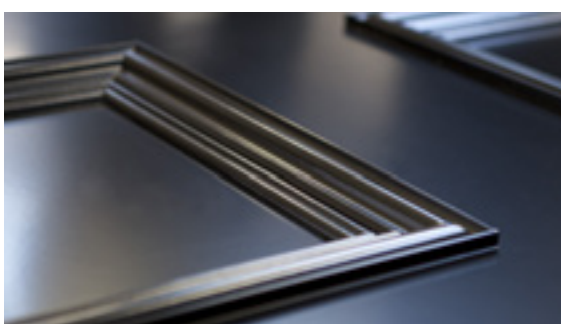
FRENCH POLISHING

Traditional French polishing is a technique that results in a very high gloss surface and is offered either prior to delivery or on site if required.



FACTORY PAINTED

A hard wearing pigmented lacquer finish is applied using modern spray equipment. Any RAL colour can be selected at varying gloss levels.



PRIMED FOR ON-SITE PAINTING

A white primer finish is applied using modern spray equipment.
